1. What is the EPF Congress?

This event will provide an exceptional opportunity for dialogue and engagement with a wide range of health players who work hard to make patient involvement happen. We will exchange best practices and knowledge to help create a framework for more structured and effective patient involvement across health systems and services.

2. How to apply?

If you are interested in benefiting from a travel grant you can [submit an application](#) by **30 June 2019**. You will have to indicate your personal details, your motivation to attend the Congress and what added value you will bring to the debate (case studies etc) on the topic of patient involvement.

EPF offers a total of 10 travel grants covering registration fee, accommodation and travel costs EPF gala dinner.

3. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be primarily:

- Affiliated and non-affiliated patient advocates /representatives.

Applicants must:

- **Commit** to attend the entirety of the event and actively contribute and produce a follow up report;
- Have **working knowledge of English** at minimum at Upper Intermediate level (B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), meaning: "You can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite easy".

Should we have the capacity, we may also consider other profiles such as:

- Academics;
- Healthcare professionals;
- Students in the Health sector;

- Representatives from Health NGOs;
- National authority high level representative from low income country.

EPF will carefully analyse all applications and select them also to ensure gender and nationality balance.
